Terms and Conditions of Entry and Competition

1. Always follow the instructions of the Stewards and Officials.
2. You will be asked to provide emergency contact details on the entry form.
3. Everyone attending the event is responsible for ensuring the safety of themselves and others.
4. Unruly or inappropriate behaviour will be grounds for disqualification from the Competition.
4. No dogs other than registered assistance dogs are allowed at the venue.
5. Once registration has been accepted and teams notified, payment in Canadian funds will be due within 1 week.
6. Forfeiture of Fees: Failure to exhibit will entail forfeiture of entry fees and no refund will be made in any circumstances.
7. Exhibitors Admission Tickets: All exhibitors will be supplied with wristbands according to the number of team members. It should be noted that all passes are issued for the use of the exhibitor only and are strictly non-transferable. Provision will be made for additional tickets to be purchased on acceptance of your entry (at the advanced price).
8. Vehicle Parking: Parking at the venue is free for everyone. There are 2 entrances off of 18th Street and the best one to use is the south entrance (Queens Ave). Once in the complex you will head south, then east to go around the majority of the facility to get to Barn 11. There will be designated areas for trucks and trailers close to the barns but there are plenty of places to park anywhere else on the grounds as well.
9. Safety. The organizers of this Show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.

Cancellations

If the event is canceled by the organizers, the entry fee will be refunded less \$20 administration cost.

On the entry form you will be asked to give your consent for your photographs and video footage to be used by The World Clydesdale Show 2023 in printed, online or electronic publications, which may be shared publicly.
