

Driving instructions from Winnipeg to Brandon

When you get your car from the Winnipeg International Airport and leave the grounds you will be heading east on Wellington Ave. Stay on Wellington until you reach King Edward Street (about 2 blocks). Once at King Edward Street turn right and head south. In about 3 kilometers you will veer right and take the exit onto Portage Avenue. (By the way, King Edward changes to being called Century Street about half way to Portage Ave)

Continue heading west on Portage Avenue (also called TransCanada Hwy, and Hwy #1) and stay on this till you reach Brandon. It is about 220km to Brandon from Winnipeg. You will go through towns in this order: Headingly (just outside of Winnipeg), St Francis Xavier (you will see a white horse on the north side of the road), Elie (you will see lots of straw stacks on the south side of the road for our closed down straw board plant), Oakville, Portage La Prairie (you can either go through or take the by pass around; you pick), MacGregor, Austin, Sydney, Carberry, Douglas and then Brandon.
