### **Venue Location**

The Keystone Center sits on 90 acres in Brandon's commercial district with easy access off the main thoroughfare of 18<sup>th</sup> Street. It is a 540,000 square foot multi-use facility all under one roof. Within walking distance are Hotels, Restaurants and Convenience Shopping.

Brandon is just over 2 hours west of Winnipeg. You can fly there but only via Calgary Alberta, otherwise you would fly to Winnipeg International Airport and then rent a vehicle and drive to Brandon. Driving instructions can be provided.

### **Hotel**

There are a number of hotels in close proximity to the venue, however 50 rooms have been set aside for Farriers entering the competition at the Colonial Inn, a short walking distance from the venue. The cost of these rooms ranges from \$98.30-\$120.70 CAD based on occupancy and beds needed. All prices include tax and continental breakfast.

### **Location of Farrier Competition**

The competition is located in Barn #11 which is in the North East area of the facility. It can be accessed through the facility as well as from the outside/parking lot. Public access will be limited to specific areas and there is no charge for spectators. There will be a spectator grandstand for seating to watch all competitions.

There will be 6 fires fuelled by coke and exact timing for the classes will be sent out to all teams once the entries are finalized.

### **Parking**

Parking at the venue is free for everyone. There are 2 entrances off of 18<sup>th</sup> Street and the best one to use is the south entrance (Queens Ave). Once in the complex you will head south, then east to go around the majority of the facility to get to Barn 11. There will be designated areas for trucks and trailers close to the barns but there are plenty of places to park anywhere else on the grounds as well.

### **Competitor Access**

Access to the Farrier Competition, barns and everything **besides** the 2 main Show Arenas are free. Wrist bands can be purchased for Show Arena access for \$50/weekend or \$20/day. 15 yrs old and under is free. On Wednesday, access to the entire facility is free. If you would like to pre-order any wrist bands you can order them with your registration (otherwise \$60 at the door)

There are various concession stands throughout the facility to purchase food and drinks.
